Our funeral homes are proud to offer celebration of life services, for families in their time of need. A celebration of life service provides families the opportunity to gather and remember their loved one through a service that is highly personalized, meaningful, and unique.

Celebration services incorporate special music, family tributes, and various readings, all utilized to reflect on and pay tribute to one's life. It is an opportunity for creativity, flexibility, and uniqueness. Resources are available to customize and personalize the ceremony.

A celebrant service can be held for families who desire a memorial service and cremation, or for families desiring a more traditional service, where a casket is present.

A celebrant is ideal for:

- those without a minister or church affiliation
- those desiring a highly personalized ceremony
- those desiring a more simple or informal time to gather and reflect
- those who see themselves as spiritual but not religious.

Who is a celebrant?

A celebrant is a specially trained facilitator who helps each family create and design a funeral or memorial service in honor of their loved one. A family meeting is typically scheduled a day or two prior to the scheduled service, where family members and special friends share information with the celebrant, and offer ideas to help personalize the service. The celebrant can have as much or as little involvement as a family prefers. Our celebrant can conduct the entire service or act as a facilitator to introduce and coordinate the friends and family members who wish to speak. In short, they incorporate all the stories, songs, photos, and experiences that define the person whose life is being honored, and bring the resources together to customize a ceremony.

Where can I have a celebrant service?

Celebrant services may be held in a chapel, graveside setting, family home, banquet facility, church, or any other gathering/meeting place chosen by the family.
